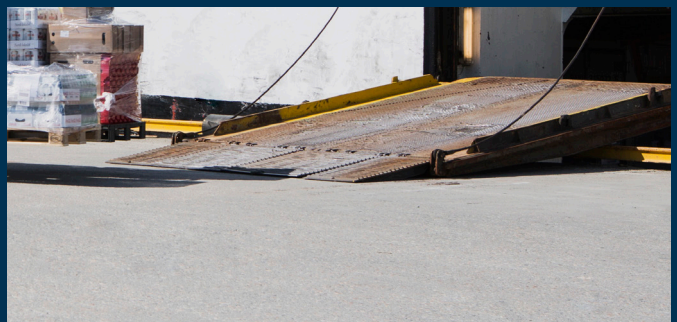

Price

Customers are obliged to pay the price according to the port tariffs, or the price according to a separate contract. Unless otherwise stated, all prices are ex. VAT and in Norwegian currency (NOK).

The minimum fee is NOK 200 per day (24 hours) or part thereof.

The quay dues shall be paid once per day (24 hours) or part thereof.

*Vestfjord ferry landing is regulated by a separate agreement.

The port offer discounts to ships registered in the Environmental Ship Index (ESI). This discount is applicable only for calls made within the validity period of the ESI certificate and where notification of registration in the ESI is given in the notice of arrival.

The following differentiated discounts apply:

- Ships with a total score of 25-50 points are entitled to a 20% discount on entry dues and quay dues.
- Ships with a total score of 50 or more points are entitled to a 30% discount on entry dues and quay dues.

The combined discount for entry dues and quay dues cannot exceed 60%.

In 2020, the Port of Bodø will introduce EPI (Environmental Port Index) pricing for arriving cruise ships. This economic incentive gives ships with low pollution a discount on quay dues based on DNV-GL's model for EPI. Ships that have less than 30 points will receive an environmental disincentive on the quay dues, while those with a high score (less pollution) will receive a discount on the quay dues. After the introduction of EPI – the ESI discount will be removed for cruise ships.

Visiting pleasure craft

Part days must be paid in the Go Marina app:

Quay dues for all visiting pleasure crafts up to 2 hours NOK 50 incl. VAT

Quay dues for visiting pleasure craft per day (24 hours) or part thereof:

Vessels under 25 feet	NOK 170 incl. VAT
Vessels between 25 and 40 feet	NOK 275 incl. VAT
Vessels between 40 and 78 feet	NOK 450 incl. VAT

The fee for visiting pleasure craft over 78 feet is based on the regulations for commercial vessels.

Long term rentals can only be arranged outside the guest season.

The guest season runs from 1 June to 31 August.

5. Charges for land-based transport

Rates for vehicles with fixed contracts

The rate for vehicles with a registered total weight of between 3.5 and 7.5 tonnes is NOK 6,600 per vehicle per year. The rate for vehicles with a registered total weight of over 7.5 tonnes is NOK 8,200 per vehicle per year. Such contracts enable unlimited driving and include parking in a designated area.

Rates for vehicles without fixed contracts

The rate for vehicles with a registered total weight of between 3.5 and 7.5 tonnes is NOK 130 per day. The rate for vehicles with a registered total weight of over 7.5 tonnes is NOK 260 per day. The rate for parking outside the designated area is NOK 110 per day.

Buses:

The rate for buses driving passengers during cruise/Hurtigruten calls is NOK 110 per bus per call.

6. Use of vehicle-mounted crane

The use of vehicle-mounted crane on the Port of Bodø's premises is NOK 250 per hour with a maximum daily rate of NOK 2,500.

7. Rental of area, buildings, car parking spaces, pleasure craft berths, etc.

Additional charges apply for the use of water and power from the Port of Bodø's installations.

An upgrade of the berths at Brygge 1 and the associated infrastructure will take place in 2020. When this is completed, the same rental prices will apply for these berths as for those at RH&M. The deposit for Brygge 1 will increase by NOK 15,000 to NOK 45,000 incl. VAT after the upgrade.

The deposit for berths at the various piers will vary based on the infrastructure at these piers.

Vessels which use the Port of Bodø's quays/floating piers without permission from the Port Control will be charged a fee of NOK 3,300 in addition to the ordinary entry dues and quay dues.

8. ISPS

Security charge, including ISPS fee

NOK 0.10 per GT per day (24 hours)

Cruise ships will additionally be charged on a per-passenger basis at a rate of NOK 12 per passenger on board the ship with a minimum of NOK 5,000 per call.

Users of secure areas will be charged a security fee of:

NOK 15 per m2 for rented areas and warehouses/storage areas per year

Access cards to ISPS areas:

· New card	NOK	450

· Radio transmitter	NOK	800

Visitor passes to ISPS areas may be borrowed for a maximum of 48 hours per assignment.

Over and above this 48-hour period, a fee of NOK 50 applies per day (24 hours) or part thereof.

A fee of NOK 500 per pass will be charged for any visitor passes which are not returned.

2. Fresh water (5%)

The supply of fresh water costs NOK 28.50 per tonne with a minimum charge (10m³) of NOK 285 per delivery. An on-off connection fee equivalent to one hour's work (currently NOK 650) applies for deliveries of water during regular working hours. Outside regular working hours, the actual costs will be charged.

The fee also applies for vessels moored outside other vessels. The fee applies for sale of fish and will be charged in addition to the ordinary entry dues and quay dues.

Vessels over 32 feet cannot be moored alongside the fishing fleet/sales fleet without special permission from the Port Control.

9. Rental of pneumatic fenders from the Port of Bodø

Diameter: 39 m x 4 m

Rental price per day (24 hours) per set (2): NOK 8,000

Additional charges apply for delivery, installation and retrieval.

10. Rental of walkway/gangway

Length 10 m.

Rental NOK 2,000 per day (24 hours).

Additional charges apply for delivery, installation and retrieval.

FEES, INTERESTS AND RESERVATIONS**1. Fee for illegal placement of vehicles, objects, etc.**

The placement of vehicles, objects and the like on the Port of Bodø's premises without prior approval from the Port Control will incur in a fee of NOK 1,660.

2. Invoice fee

If an invoice is issued per paper, an invoicing fee of NOK 62 will apply.

3. Late payment interests

Invoices not paid by the due date will incur interest pursuant to the provisions of the Act relating to Interest on Overdue Payments, etc.

4. Re-invoicing

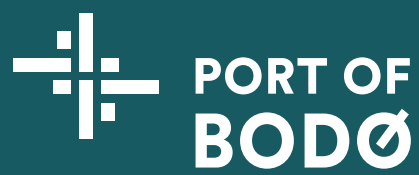
The processing fee for re-invoicing services to a third party is 10% of the total amount with a minimum fee of NOK 350.
